Abstract Creation Guidelines

-
- **Template :** Use the attached template file (abstract_template.doc).
 - **Format :** English, A4 size, black and white, one page.
 - **PDF Conversion :** After creating your abstract in Word, please convert it to a PDF file.
 - **Font Embedding :** To prevent character corruption, all fonts must be embedded in the PDF file.
 - **Figures and Tables :** Please use clear and sharp figures, charts, and photos.

Submission Method

- **Abstract Upload Deadline:** Tuesday, September 30, 2025, at 17:00 PM (JST)
 - **Upload Method:** Access the abstract upload form and upload your abstract as a PDF. The filename should be your full name (e.g., TaroYamada.pdf).
 - **Speaker's Email Address:** Please use the same email address as the one you used for your presentation application.
 - **Abstract Resubmission:** You may re-upload abstracts without limitation. However, please note that after the submission deadline, the files will immediately proceed to the printing process, and no further corrections or modifications will be accepted.

- **Copyright for the Abstract Book:** Copyright will belong to the Japanese- French Oceanographic Society.
 - **Program & Abstract Book:** This will be printed in black and white on A4 paper and distributed on the day of the symposium.
 - **Journal "La mer":** Your abstract will be included in a regular 2026 issue of the journal, printed in black and white with reduced size.
 - **Proceedings:** Proceedings are scheduled to be published by Springer in 2026-2027. We are currently considering whether they will be in color or black and white.
 - **The publication fee:** It is included in the symposium registration fee.
